SWAP Don't DROP – Monday 20 September to Friday 1 October 2021

The College is running a student **SWAP Don't DROP** campaign from Monday 20 September 2021 to Friday 1 October 2021. This is a chance to find out what else the College has to offer if you really don't think the course you are on is right for you.

Between Monday 20 September 2021 and Friday 1 October 2021, on each College Site, arrangements are in place with named contacts available to support any student who:

- ✓ needs some reassurance and perhaps some study support to help get used to being at College
- ✓ has issues other than the course that is worrying them like student finance, additional learning needs or health issues
- ✓ would like to explore other options at College including – vocational, academic and work based learning-apprenticeships

The College is able to offer you support in two ways:

- ✓ Joining a TEAMS meeting with the Student Support Team for a general conversation, setting up some study support or help with welfare and financial matters
- ✓ Attending a face to face appointment with a member of the Teaching Staff who can provide more information about a course you may be interested in
