Short: as in ham Long: as in hand C: A: Short: as in then E: Long: open e

sound (air)

Long: as in seen

i: Short: as in sit O:

Long: as in seen Short: as in gone Long: as in more F:

U: Short: as in sit

W: Short: as in wind

Y: Short: as in sit Long: as in seen

Short: as in gun

Sometimes the long vowel is marked by a circumflex e.g. "cân" or "pêl"

Consonants

As in car not cease

CH: A dry gargling sound, as in Loch

(Scottish)

DD: As in th in the

As in v in vase or f in of

FF: As in off or coffee

G: As in great not giant

NG: As in song

This sound is achieved by placing LL:

your tongue on the roof of your

mouth, then blow.

As in red but with a pronounced R:

rolling

Similar to r but followed by a gentle h RH:

TH: As in thin or pith
