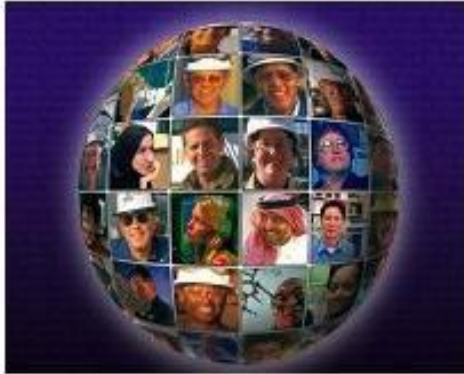


ESDGC
